



**SUPPLEMENTAL MEMO**

Re: State of Georgia v Scott Winfield Davis  
Case No. 05SC37460

The conversation around the two stop/starts and the end of tape stop is as follows:

**Stop Number 1, Side A**

SCOTT DAVIS 257-9484.

DETECTIVE What is it?

SCOTT DAVIS 257-9484

DETECTIVE 9484?

SCOTT DAVIS Hmn-hmn.

DETECTIVE Okay. You dropped off some chairs?

SCOTT DAVIS Right.

DETECTIVE How many chairs?

SCOTT DAVIS Six chairs.

DETECTIVE I need to stop this for a minute.

DETECTIVE Okay, when he put the mace on you, in your face, then he put the gun to your face and then he told you to leave Megan alone, is that correct?

SCOTT DAVIS He said you better, leave or stay away from Meg-, I don't know the exact words. Stay away from Megan or I'm going to come back and, you know, take the rest of your stuff.

**End of tape stop, Side A**

DETECTIVE                   What did you do Monday night?

SCOTT DAVIS                I went out with my, uh, friends to Three Dollar Café.

DETECTIVE                   What time did you get in?

SCOTT DAVIS                About midnight.

DETECTIVE                   Midnight?

SCOTT DAVIS                And I told them I made some phone calls and went to sleep.

DETECTIVE                   Who'd you make phone calls to?

SCOTT DAVIS                Uh, I was trying to find a girl I know from, she lives in Chicago, but she works out in San Francisco quite a bit and I was trying to get her on the phone to talk

DETECTIVE                   Okay, so what'd you do Tuesday night?

1:02:07                   **TAPE RUNS OUT AND STOPS AT END OF SIDE A**

**TAPE STARTED AT BEGINNING OF SIDE B**

DETECTIVE                   You didn't do anything tonight?

SCOTT DAVIS                I mean, you've heard the whole story about tonight.

DETECTIVE                   Well you (*unintelligible*) job.

SCOTT DAVIS                Well, I mean you heard the whole spiel I mean at least they have. From coming home from work, going to work in the morning, coming back, going to work out, taking the chairs, coming home and then all the stuff happened.

**Stop Number 2, Side B**

**DETECTIVE** His left hand. Where's the mace at now?

**SCOTT DAVIS** It's at, in the trash can at my house *(unintelligible)*

**DETECTIVE** Ah, so when he came at you with the mace in his hand, he had the gun in his other hand?

**SCOTT DAVIS** I assume so, I don't know. I got sprayed in the face with mace and, you know, you can't really see.

**DETECTIVE** I know

**SCOTT DAVIS** It gets in your eyes so I just felt the gun to my head.

**DETECTIVE** Do you want some water, something to drink? You want some water?

**SCOTT DAVIS** *(mumbled response)*

**17:21** **TAPE STOPPED AND RE-STARTED**


**DETECTIVE** Okay.
